Religious Text	Place of Worship	Hindu Shrine A place in the home dedicated to worshipping a deity
 <p>The special texts in Hinduism are called the <b>Vedas</b>.</p>	<p>A Hindu place of worship is called a <b>Mandir</b>.</p> 	 <p><b>Murti</b>—a statue or picture of a deity. When looking at a murti Hindu people believe they are meeting the God.</p> <p><b>Bell</b>—to make a sound so God knows someone has come to worship.</p> <p><b>Incense</b>—a nice smell to clean the air.</p> <p><b>Diya Lamp</b>—this will be moved around to bring light to the shrine showing God's presence.</p> <p><b>Kum Kum powder</b>—a red powder to mark the forehead as a sign of respect and devotion to God.</p> <p><b>Tray for Prashad</b>— Hindu people offer blessed food and flowers to the God. This special food is called Prashad.</p> <p><b>Water and spoon</b>—a sign of welcome and respect to God. In India people welcome someone into a house with water to drink and wash with.</p>
<p><b>Sticky Learning</b></p> <p>Hindu people worship in a <b>Mandir</b> or at home. Hindu people have a <b>shrine</b> at home to use for <b>worship</b>. In Hinduism, there is one God (<b>Brahman</b>) that comes in many forms. Each form of God is called a <b>deity</b> and is special in a different way.</p>
