As the earth spins, it makes the sun appear to rise in the east in the morning. Because the sun hits an object at an angle, the shadow is lona.


As the earth continues to spin the sun is overhead by midday. Because the sun hits the object from above, the shadow is short.


As the earth spins and the sun sets in the west in the evening, the shadow is long.

1.) We can see objects because light reflects off them and into our eyes. 2.) Light reflects off most objects, especially colours like white and yellow. 3.) If there is no light at all (pitchblack), then there is no light to reflect and we can't see anything at all.
4.) At night you can still see a bit in the dark because the moon is reflecting light.
